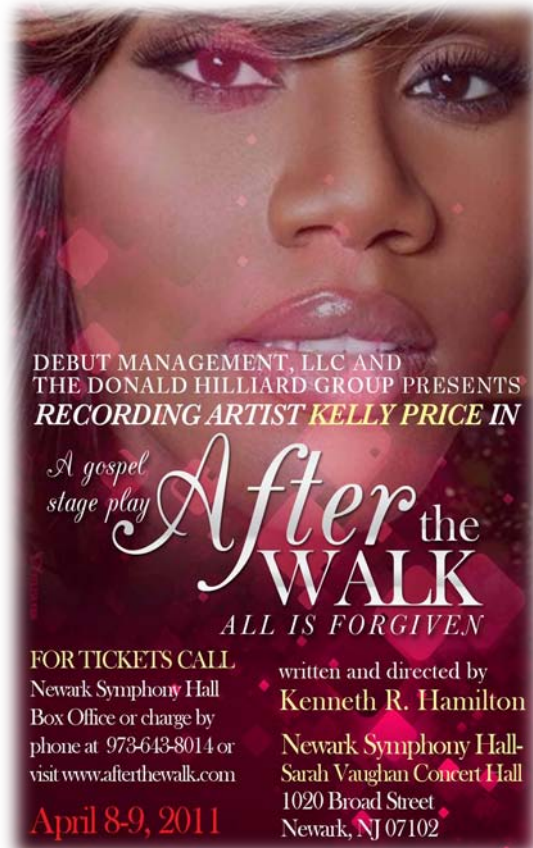


# *After the Walk- ALL IS FORGIVEN*

**T**ragedy and infidelity does not have to end a relationship. In *After the Walk*, Faythe and Maxwell endure the storms of a broken marriage and crumbling faith. Having the right people in your ear and feeding your spirit will build your character to a point where you can accomplish things you never thought you could. Even when temptation invades the sanctity of the church and spiritual leaders face their own vulnerabilities, faith will still bring you through. *After the Walk* is not your typical stage play that exploits the black church experience. Instead it takes an everyday occurrence and shares an incredible story of forgiveness to inspire and uplift the audience. The acting is great. The music is inspiring but the story is EXTRAORDINARY. The amazing cast includes, Grammy nominated, *Kelly Price* who takes it to another level as she portrays the revengeful and conniving Robyn Johnston who lurks in the pews looking for her prey. She becomes the villainess you can't help but love. She exemplifies a scorned woman who by learning to forgive is able to redirect her energy to pursue her own passion.

**N**ewark's own *Valarie Adams* plays the soulful, sassy Miss Ronnie who brings the house down with her zany, eccentric persona and extraordinary rendition of Walk Around Heaven. R&B singer, *Andre Davis* plays the lovable Pastor Franklin Scott who struggles to



find the balance between home and family. You will fall in love with Franklin Scott. *Kelly Downing* brings her gift to this production as Franklin's wife who despite her role as the first lady, convinces herself that the prestige is filled with inconveniences that she's not sure she wants to tolerate. *Keva Moolanaar* plays Faythe. Her past indiscretions continues to haunt her family. She tries to escape the effects of her past but until she learns to forgive and let go, she will never be completely forgiven. Actor and model, *Shammah Solomon* plays the handsome and irresistible Maxwell Roberts who finds it in his heart to forgive his wife for breaking their vows which ultimately costs his daughter's life. Rip the Runway Model, *Frederick (Fox) Salomon* is the suave and handsome Khalil Harris who is released from prison and tries to find a way to make peace with his past mistakes so that he can live a clean and spiritual life. But his crime is so egregious that forgiveness doesn't come easy. Gospel recording artist, *Cyndi Bell Pinkney* plays the overconfident and super diva, Sis Carmen. *Leah Hilliard* is Sandy McKinney who is estranged from her own father who places his church before his family and lost his daughter in the process. Caribbean actor extraordinaire, *Everton Bailey* plays the wise and witty, Langston Smith who knows a little bit about a lot and gives his advice even when it's unsolicited. *Janna Hughes* gives a vocal performance that is sure to leave you speechless. Comedian *Del Harrison* brings just enough humor to break the ice without overshadowing the message of the production. And the insightful, charismatic, *Bishop Donald Hilliard Jr*, plays himself as he shares his spiritual wisdom with a young pastor who needs to find the delicate balance between leading his church and being a husband to his wife.

**A**fter the Walk is entertaining and inspiring. So many stories are told of men who betray their wives. But few stories are told about the countless women who find themselves caught in a love triangle. When it's time to choose between, her husband, her lover and her faith, who will withstand the test of time? In this story, we see that not all men are careless lovers. In fact, more often than not, men also must face their insecurities, swallow their pride and learn to forgive.
